HIS edition is the fruit of several years of research spent in the acquisition of autograph manuscripts of Chopin's works. A complete set of the original French edition in seven volumes (unprocurable nowadays) was ultimately obtained, and the present Oxford edition, based thereon, is entirely free from the additions, alterations, and vulgar 'improvements' with which editors have since sought to mar Chopin's own magnificent writing. At the end of the seventh volume of this first French edition is a general index written in part by Chopin himself—ample evidence of his approval of it. Moreover, various corrections, annotations, and variants which appear in Chopin's writing are collated in the Oxford edition.

Preface and notes are in English, French, and German.

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
